BENTON, MISSOURI - Scott County Sheriff Rick Walter said today that an investigation into narcotics activity has lead to the arrest of two Scott City residents.

Tracy K. Williams (44) and Brandy S. Williams (28) have both been charged with manufacturing a controlled substance, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and four counts of endangering the welfare of a child. Bond has been set at \$100,000 on Tracy Williams and \$50,000 on Brandy Williams.

Walter said a search warrant was served late Wednesday night at the Williams residence. The search warrant was obtained after investigators received information that narcotic's were being used at the residence.

Walter said during the search deputies found a container with mixed chemicals, commonly associated with the manufacturing of methamphetamine, along with other chemicals, drug paraphernalia, and a white powder substance believed to be methamphetamine.

Walter said deputies also discovered four small children ranging in age from 1 to 6, in the home during the search. The children were turned over to the Division of Child Services and later placed in foster care pending further investigation.
